

LOVF ANNUAL RAFFLE

The Lions of Virginia Foundation raffle drawing will be held on Sunday, April 25, 2021 at 1:00 PM. This is the same day and approximate time that the raffle drawing would occur if the annual Lions of Virginia Convention were being held as planned in Northern Virginia. However, since the convention was cancelled, the drawing will take place in Roanoke.

As always, the booklets which you are turning in should remain stapled. Please do not pull out the staples! Also, payment needs to accompany the booklets which you are turning in. If payment does not accompany the submitted booklets, those tickets will not go into the “drum”. We also ask that you minimize the number of checks covering the booklets which are being turned in. Ideally, there is one club check to cover your submission (as opposed to separate checks from individual Lions buying a book).

Ticket stubs, and the accompanying payment (checks please, NO CASH) can be returned in one of two (2) ways.

The Representatives need to have your tickets no later than April 14, 2021, so that they can forward them to Lion Jim.
